Request for Beneficial Use

Please provide the below information to the Division of Remediation:

- 1) Provide the address and site of origin of the material to be beneficially used.
- 2) Provide a description of the chemical and physical characteristics of the material to be beneficially used; including laboratory analytical data, and a description of the quantity and source of the solid waste.
- 3) Provide any figures, tables or site characterization of the soils that are to be re-used.
- 4) A description of how release of solid waste into the environment will be prevented;
- 5) The receiving party shall provide a description of the proposed methods of handling, storing, and utilizing the beneficial use material to ensure that it will not adversely affect the public health or safety or the environment. This description shall include, at a minimum, the procedures to be employed for placement of the material; the intended storage procedures; and recordkeeping procedures. Storage procedures should include run-on/run-off control, the maximum anticipated inventory, measures to ensure that no contamination of underlying soil or groundwater occurs, and measures for dispersion control due to wind or precipitation events. If the soils are to be stockpiled for more than 1 calendar year, a stockpile management plan is required from the receiving party.

A written determination will be sent to the requesting party defining whether the request for beneficial use is approved and any conditions for such use.

Please allow at a minimum 45 days for review of any request.
